Any remaining property shall be identified as either "Athletics Specific Equipment" or "other non-athletic equipment assets" (a) Athletics specific equipment shall be transferred to another organisation(s) that has Objects similar to those of the Centre and which prohibit the distribution of its or their income and property among its or their Members to an extent at least as great as that imposed on the Centre by this Constitution. Such organisation(s) is to be determined by the Members in a general meeting at or before the time of dissolution, or in default thereof by the management committee of the Winston Hills Sports Club. If this does not occur, the decision is to be made by a judge of the Supreme Court of New South Wales or other court as may have or acquire jurisdiction in the matter.

(b) All other non-athletic equipment assets shall be transferred to Winston Hills Sports Club Ltd.

33.3 Property to be Transferred to Similar Organisation

Any remaining property shall be shall be transferred to another organisation(s) that has Objects similar to those of the Centre and which prohibit the distribution of its or their income and property among its or their Members to an extent at leastas great as that imposed on the Centre by this Constitution. Such organisation(s) is to be determined by the Members in a general meeting at or before the time of dissolution, or in default thereof to other athletics clubs in New South Wales. If this does not occur, the decision is to be made by a judge of the Supreme Court of New South Wales or other court as may have or acquire jurisdiction in the matter.
